Following that theme, the "saloon" is decked out with charred hardwood floors, gilded silver ball-and-claw barstools and a vintage ceramic absinthe fountain that recalls the throat-burning spirit's glory days. The Wild West vibe extends to the food offerings, which includes rib-stickers like pot pie stuffed with bone marrow and beef shank.
