## History on Ice

Named after Henry Comstock and the famed Comstock Lode, which brought mining fortunes to the City by the Bay, newly opened **Comstock Saloon** is a throwback to the city's Barbary Coast era, serving as a San Franciscan watering hole since 1907. The new venture from renowned barmen Jeff Hollinger and Jonny Raglin of Absinthe Brasserie & Bar offers carefully crafted classic cocktails—think Manhattans, Negronis and Martinis, as well as refined turn-of-the-century saloon fare, like beef shank and bone marrow pot pie, grilled quail with oyster stuffing, potted pork and more.
